### Case Summary:

A protest against the International Jury sent to the Organizing Authority.

### Procedural Matters:

1. The hearing was heard by a panel of three members in accordance with RRS N1.4(b).
2. The father of SGP 52 sent an email to the Organizing Authority on 25 April at 19:56 to protest against the International Jury "for refusing for a redress hearing" for his son.
3. The international Jury changed the type of hearing to a request for redress based on the content of the request, as permitted by RRS 63.1(c).

### Facts Found:

1. POL 28 protested against SGP 52 in Case 2 on 25 April at 14:38.
2. The International Jury decided Case 2 on 25 April at 16:54.
3. SGP 52 requested to reopen Hearing 2 on 25 April at 17:27 (Case 9).
4. The International Jury decided not to reopen Hearing 2 on 25 April at 19:03.
5. SGP 52 requested redress based on the decision of the International Jury not to reopen Hearing 2, on 25 April at 19:45.

### Conclusion & Rules:

1. A boat that is a party to a hearing may not request redress based a decision from that hearing. RRS 62.1(a) applies.
