Case Summary:

boat/boat protest and request for redress

Procedural Matters:

ITA 218910 did not come to the hearing, the hearing proceeded in accordance with RRS 63.3(b).

Facts Found:

- 1. ILCA 7 Race 2 first leeward mark, 20-25 kn of wind:
- 2. ITA 218910 made a wide rounding around the starboard gate mark clear ahead of CAN 217718, both boats on starboard tack.
- 3. After the rounding CAN 217718 was half a boat length windward and astern of ITA 218910.
- 4. ITA 218910 sailed four boat lengths and tacked in front of CAN 217718.
- 5. The distance between ITA 218910 and CAN 217718 after the tack was less than one metre.
- 6. CAN 217718 bore away and hit ITA 218910 half a metre from the transom.
- 7. The helm of CAN 217718 became entangled in the mainsheet of ITA 218910 and capzised.
- 8. CAN dropped from position 13 to last position.
- 9. No damage and injury occurred.
- 10. No boat took a penalty.

Conclusion & Rules:

- 1. ITA 218910 on port failed to keep clear of CAN 217718 on starboard, and broke RRS 10 and 14.
- 2. It was not reasonably possible for CAN 217718, the right-of-way boat, to avoid contact with ITA 218910 when it was clear that ITA 218910 was not keeping clear. CAN 217718 did not break RRS 14.
- 3. As there was no damage to CAN 21718, the requirements for redress under RR 62.1 are not met.
