Procedural Matters: -

Facts Found: —

- 1 Starting sequence of race 14, under black flag and general recall
- 2 POL 72 sail number was written on a board on the Race Committee vessel, as BFD.
- 3 POL 72 did not start in the re-started race 14
- 4 POL 72 was scored BFD
- 5 After checking their records, the Race Commitee found that POL 72 was not over the line at her starting signal.

Conclusion & Rules: -

By not starting after being displayed as BFD, POL 72 complied with RRS 30.4

POL 72's score in race 14 was made significantly worse through no fault of her own by an improper action the race committee.

Therefore the requirements of RRS 62.1(a) are met.

Decision: -

Redress is given to POL 72. POL72 is to be scored in race 14 average points based on the Course and Marathon Races in the opening series, without considering Slalom Races, calculated as per RRS A9(a), subject to WS Case 116.

IQFoil M: Redress is given to POL 72. POL72 is to be scored in race 14 average points based on the Course and Marathon Races in the opening series, without considering Slalom Races, calculated as per 28/04 RRS A9(a), subject to WS Case 116.
