Downwind port-starboard incident

Procedural Matters: -

Heard by 3 person panel under RRS N1.4(b)

Facts Found:

- 1. Wind 12-15 knots.
- 2. Downwind leg.
- 3. GBR 379 was on starboard tack and ESP 411 on port tack.
- 4. Boats were on converging courses and holding courses.
- 5. At 5 lengths distance between boats, ESP 411 was aiming the bow of GBR 379.
- 6. At 4 lengths distance between boats, ESP 411 is luffing slowly and was aiming the Middle of GBR 379.
- 7. At 2 lengths distance between boats, GBR 379 bore away sharply.
- 8. GBR 379's helmswoman moved from trapeze to inside the boat.
- 9. ESP 411 passed astern of GBR 379. The minimal distance between the hulls was appr. one boat length.
- 10. No contact, no injuries.
- 11. No boat took any penalty turn.

Conclusion & Rules: -

There was a reasonable apprehension of collision on the part of GBR 379.

ESP 411 on port failed to keep clear of GBR 379 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
