# **Procedural Matters:**

## Facts Found:

- 1. The wind was 20 kts, with 1 meter choppy waves. The boats where travelling at a speed of 18 kts.
- 2. NZL 18 and POL 7 where on starboard tack on a run downwind with POL 7, 40 meters clear ahead and 30 to windward of NZL 18.
- 3. POL 7 gibed to port tack, going into a converging course with NZL 18.
- 4. NZL 18 was aiming at the back end of POL 7's wing.
- 5. NZL 18 luffed, and crossed 2 meters astern of POL 7.

#### Conclusion & Rules: -

1. POL 7 on port failed to keep clear of NZL 18 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.

### Decision: -

1. POL 7 is DSQ in race 3
