AMENDMENT TO SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The following changes in NoR, SI, Equipment Regulations and Support Team Regulations apply to the Medal Races and Medal Series on Saturday, 30th April 2022. The rules of this notice override any conflicting rules in the Notice of Race and the Sailing Instructions.

1. Add new NoR 1.1.6: Addendum FMS - Formula Kite Medal Series of this notice applies to the Formula Kite Medal Series.
2. Delete SI 1.2, 3.1, 19.4, 19.5 and 19.6.
3. Delete SI 2.1 and insert new SI 2.1 as follows:
 - 2.1. Notices to competitors and changes to the SI or Schedule of Races will be posted on either:
 - a) on the Official Notice Board located on line at: <https://sof.ffvoile.fr/official-notice-board/>
 - b) the race committee starting vessel, after Flag D is displayed and may be communicated orally.
4. Delete SI 5.3 and insert new SI 5.3 as follows:

5.3 When flag AP is displayed ashore, 1 minute' in race signal AP is replaced with the minutes indicated in the table below (This changes Race Signal AP):

Race areas	AP: Replace 1 minute with not less than or ...Minutes after flag D is displayed
Race Area Alpha and Bravo	20 minutes

5. Delete SI 10 and insert new SI 10 as follows:

10. MARKS

10.1 Course marks, will be as follows:

Race Areas	Marks 1, 2, 3, 4 and 1A	New Marks
ALPHA	ORANGE	GREEN
BRAVO	GREEN	None
CHARLIE	RED	YELLOW

- 10.2 The starting marks will be race committee vessels or a White mark.
- 10.3 The finishing marks will be a race committee vessel and a WHITE mark.
- 10.4 Protector mark for Formula Kite Course, will be ORANGE.

6.Delete SI 11.3 and insert new SI 11.3 as follows

- 11.3 The starting line will be between:
 - a) staffs displaying orange flags on the starting marks
 - b) or a staff displaying an orange flag at one end and the course side of a white mark at the other end.

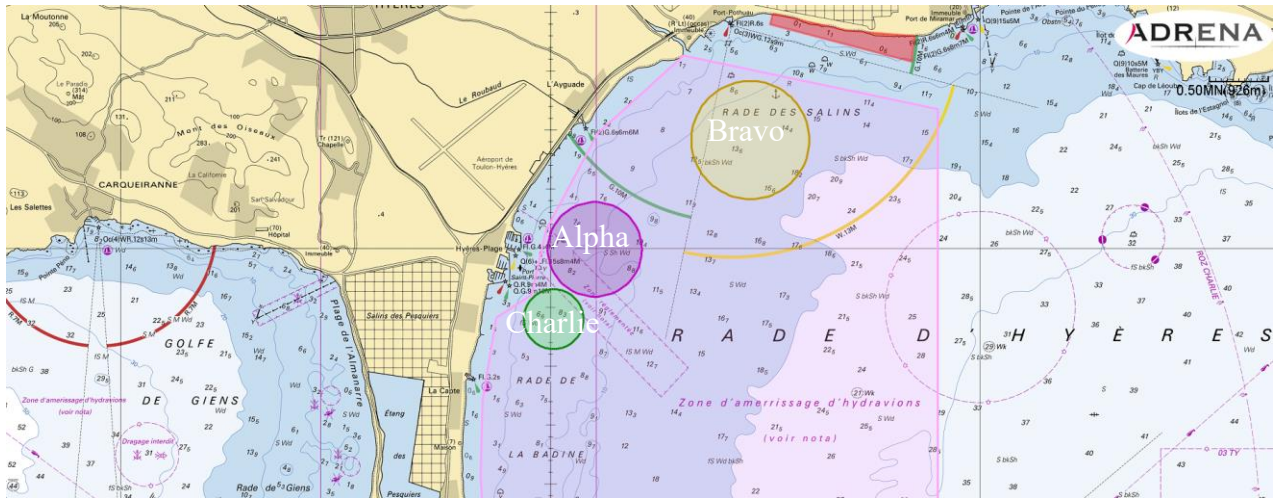
7. Add new Equipment Regulation 4.6:

[SP] Boats shall be available for inspection at the equipment inspection/pit lane area at the scheduled time (See table below). A penalty given under this this item shall not be grounds for a boat to request redress. This changes RRS 60.1(b). The infringement of this item will be penalized with 1 point.

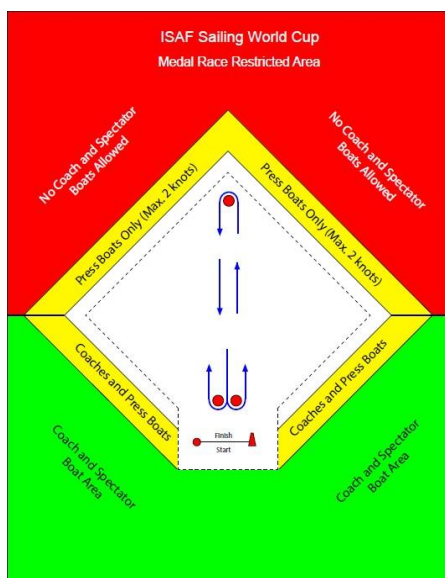

13. Add SI Addendum FMS - FORMULA KITE FINALS

(Version 28 March 2022) – This addendum applies to all medal series races and all pre-race or post-race activities related to them. The rules of this addendum override any conflicting rules in the notice of race and the sailing instructions. This changes rule 63.7.

FMS 1 SCORING INFORMATION

At the finishing line, the race committee will display each kiteboard's finishing place or score in the race, together with flag B and one sound. The scoring information and flag B will be displayed for one minute and removed with one sound. If the race committee changes the scoring information while it is displayed, it will display flag L with one sound. The scoring information and flag B will continue to be displayed for one minute after any changes are made.

FMS 2 PROTESTS AND REQUESTS FOR REDRESS

- FMS 2.1 Protests and requests for redress need not be in writing. The protest committee may schedule the hearing, inform the parties of the time and place of the hearing, take evidence, conduct the hearing, and communicate its decision in any way it considers appropriate, which may be orally. This changes rules 61.2, 62.2, 63 and 65.
- FMS 2.2 Hearing requests concerning incidents in the racing area shall be delivered to the race committee finishing vessel during the display of flag B. Other hearing requests shall be delivered to the protest committee station as soon as reasonably possible after learning of the reasons for making them. The protest committee shall extend the time limit if there is good reason to do so. This changes rules 61.2, 61.3 and 62.2.
- FMS 2.3 (a) When the race committee receives a notification of protest or request for redress, it will promptly display a yellow flag with one sound and inform the protest committee. The hearing will start at the protest committee station within five minutes after the flag has been displayed unless the protest committee decides otherwise.
- (b) If no protest or request for redress is received when flag B is removed, the race committee will display a green and white flag with one sound.
- FMS 2.4 A member of the protest committee who is a witness may give evidence remotely.
- FMS 2.5 After making its decision, the protest committee will display any penalties imposed or redress given together with flag L and one sound.
- FMS 2.6 Rule 66.2 is deleted.
- FM 2.7 In accordance with rule 70.5(a), decisions made by the jury on protests and requests in the Semi-finals will be final even when the panel does not comply with Appendix N.
- FMS 2.8 The time limit in rule N1.4 will be 1 minute.
