Case Summary:

Procedural Matters:

Facts Found:

1. The wind was 20 kts, with 1 meter choppy waves. The boats were travelling at a speed of 18 kts.
2. NZL 18 and POL 7 were on starboard tack on a run downwind with POL 7, 40 meters clear ahead and 30 to windward of NZL 18.
3. POL 7 gibed to port tack, going into a converging course with NZL 18.
4. NZL 18 was aiming at the back end of POL 7's wing.
5. NZL 18 luffed, and crossed 2 meters astern of POL 7.

Conclusion & Rules:

1. POL 7 on port failed to keep clear of NZL 18 on starboard, and broke RRS 10.
