A leward mark rounding incident in race 6

Procedural Matters: -

Facts Found: -

Approaching the gate mark to be left onto port

A group of boats approached the mark clear ahead of GBR 219391 and TUR 219853

GBR 219391 entered the zone on port, clear ahead of TUR 219853 on starboard

In the zone, GBR 219391 slowed down by pulling in her mainsail to give mark room to the group of boats clear ahead of her.

Just before rounding the mark, GBR 219391 luffed to round the mark

TUR 219853 gybed and made an inside overlap between GBR 219391 and the mark

There was contact between TUR 219853's right side and GBR 219391's left side

No boat took a penalty turn

Conclusion & Rules: -

TUR 219853 clear astern at the time GBR 219391 reached the zone failed to give GBR 219391 mark-room, and broke RRS 18.2(b).

TUR 219853 is DSQ race 6
