## Facts Found:

- 1. Wind speed was 13 knots light choppy sea.
- 2. FRA 44 and USA 43 were close-hauled with FRA 44 on starboard and USA 43 on port on a converging course.
- 3. USA43 held her course.
- 4. FRA 44 bore away about 20 degrees half-boat distance from USA 43.
- 5. The crew of FRA 44 touched the water and recovered immediately.
- 6. No penalty was taken

## Conclusion & Rules:

FRA 44, the right away boat, could not sail her course with no need to take avoiding action and therefore USA 43 broke RRS 10.
